


STEP 1: Loosen set screw by turning counterclockwise, using the allan wrench located inside the handle.



STEP 2: Remove head of JackTight from handle.



STEP 3: Remove spool from rod.



STEP 4: Replace rubber tubing with new tubing found in handle by sliding worn tube downward to remove and sliding new tube upward to replace.



STEP 5: Reassemble JackTight.



WARNING: Do not try to loosen set screw at the top of JackTight. This will damage your tool.
